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The Prophet Elijah Miracles

The Lord God performed many miracles through His Prophet Elijah that are recorded In the Book of 1 King chapters 17. God cause a drought to occur over Israel for three years. During this time God sent Elijah to the brook Kerith in the area where it enters into the Jordan River, until it dried up. During which time the Ravens brought him bread and meat to eat.

After the brook had dried up the Lord sent him to a widow who lived in the city Zarephath that belonged to the king of Zidon. When Elijah arrived at Zarephath the widow was gathering sticks, to bake some bread from the last of the flower and oil she had and was going to use it to make a final meal for her and her son and then die of starvation. Elijah ask her for some water and for her to make him some bread first and then, make some for themselves and if she would do so, the containers of flower and oil would not go empty until it started to rain again.

The container of flower and container of oil didn't go empty. After a time the widow's son dies causing the woman to ask Elijah, why would God allow her son to die, as He had used her to care for His Prophet? Elijah carries her son up to his room in the loft and stretched out on the boy three times and cried out to God asking Him to cause the boy's soul to come back into him. The boy came back to life and Elijah brought the boy back to his mother, so she believed Elisha was from God, 1 Kings 17:1-24.

1 Kings 17:1-24 Now Elijah the Tishbite, from Tishbe in Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the Lord , the God of Israel, lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word." 2 Then the word of the Lord came to Elijah: 3 "Leave here, turn eastward and hide in the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan. 4 You will drink from the brook, and I have ordered the ravens to feed you there." 5 So he did what the Lord had told him. He went to the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan, and stayed there. 6 The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he drank from the brook. 7 Sometime later the brook dried up because there had been no rain in the land. 8 Then the word of the Lord came to him: 9 "Go at once to Zarephath of Sidon and

stay there. I have commanded a widow in that place to supply you with food." 10 So he went to Zarephath. When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked, "Would you bring me a little water in a jar so I may have a drink?" 11 As she was going to get it, he called, "And bring me, please, a piece of bread." 12 "As surely as the Lord your God lives," she replied, "I don't have any bread-only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my son, that we may eat it-and die." 13 Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small cake of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. 14 For this is what the Lord , the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord gives rain on the land.' " 15 She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. 16 For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah. 17 Sometime later the son of the woman who owned the house became ill. He grew worse and worse, and finally stopped breathing. 18 She said to Elijah, "What do you have against me, man of God? Did you come to remind me of my sin and kill my son?" 19 "Give me your son," Elijah replied. He took him from her arms, carried him to the upper room where he was staying,and laid him on his bed. 20 Then he cried out to the Lord , "O Lord my God, have you brought tragedy also upon this widow I am staying with, by causing her son to die?" 21 Then he stretched himself out on the boy three times and cried to the Lord , "O Lord my God, let this boy's life return to him!" 22 The Lord heard Elijah's cry, and the boy's life returned to him, and he lived. 23 Elijah picked up the child and carried him down from the room into the house. He gave him to his mother and said, "Look, your son is alive!" 24 Then the woman said to Elijah, "Now I know that you are a man of God and that the word of the Lord from your mouth is the truth."

After three years the Lord sent Elijah back to Israel to confront King Ahab, during

this time Jezebel had been killing the Prophets of God. On the way Elijah met the man in charge of Ahab's house, by the name of Obadiah. Obadiah had been providing food from the king's house to feed one hundred of God's prophets, that Jezebel hadn't been able to kill. Obadiah had hidden 100 prophets in two different caves, 50 in each cave where he cared for them, feeding them bread and water throughout the duration of the drought.

King Ahab had been seeking Elijah for three years, asking anyone if they knew where Elijah was and if anyone told the king where Elijah was and Elijah was not found they were killed. During this time Jezebel was killing God's Prophets. When Elijah told Obadiah to go tell King Ahab he had seen Elijah and the king didn't find him, he too would be killed. Elijah assured Obadiah that he would meet with the king and not to worry he wouldn't be killed, 1Kings 18:1-16.

1 Kings 18:1-16 After a long time, in the third year, the word of the Lord came to Elijah: "Go and present yourself to Ahab, and I will send rain on the land." 2 So Elijah went to present himself to Ahab. Now the famine was severe in Samaria, 3 and Ahab had summoned Obadiah, who was in charge of his palace. (Obadiah was a devout believer in the Lord . 4 While Jezebel was killing off the Lord 's prophets, Obadiah had taken a hundred prophets and hidden them in two caves, fifty in each, and had supplied them with food and water.) 5 Ahab had said to Obadiah, "Go through the land to all the springs and valleys. Maybe we can find some grass to keep the horses and mules alive so we will not have to kill any of our animals." 6 So they divided the land they were to cover, Ahab going in one direction and Obadiah in another. 7 As Obadiah was walking along, Elijah met him. Obadiah recognized him, bowed down to the ground, and said, "Is it really you, my lord Elijah?" 8 "Yes," he replied. "Go tell your master, 'Elijah is here.' " 9 "What have I done wrong," asked Obadiah, "that you are handing your servant over to Ahab to be put to death? 10 As surely as the Lord your God lives, there is not a nation or kingdom where my master has not sent someone to look for you. And whenever a nation or kingdom claimed you were not there, he made them swear they could not find you. 11 But now you tell me to go to my master and say, 'Elijah is here.' 12 I don't know where the Spirit of the Lord may carry you when I leave you. If I

go and tell Ahab and he doesn't find you, he will kill me. Yet I your servant have worshiped the Lord since my youth. 13 Haven't you heard, my lord, what I did while Jezebel was killing the prophets of the Lord? I hid a hundred of the Lord 's prophets in two caves, fifty in each, and supplied them with food and water. 14 And now you tell me to go to my master and say, 'Elijah is here.' He will kill me!" 15 Elijah said, "As the Lord Almighty lives, whom I serve, I will surely present myself to Ahab today." 16 So Obadiah went to meet Ahab and told him, and Ahab went to meet Elijah.

Upon meeting with him King Ahab accused Elijah of causing the drought to take place, but Elijah said it was because Ahab and the house of his father have forsaken God's commandments and followed after their god baalim. Elijah told Ahab to send and gather to him all of Israel unto Mount Carmel and all the prophets of baal 450 and the prophets of the grove 400 who eat at Jezebel's table, 1 Kings 18:17-22.

1 Kings 18:17-22 When he saw Elijah, he said to him, "Is that you, you troubler of Israel?" 18" I have not made trouble for Israel," Elijah replied. "But you and your father's family have. You have abandoned the Lord 's commands and have followed the Baals." 19 Now summon the people from all over Israel to meet me on Mount Carmel. And bring the four hundred and fifty prophets of Baal and the four hundred prophets of Asherah, who eat at Jezebel's table." 20 So Ahab sent word throughout all Israel and assembled the prophets on Mount Carmel. 21 Elijah went before the people and said, "How long will you waver between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow him; but if Baal is God, follow him." But the people said nothing. 22 Then Elijah said to them, "I am the only one of the Lord 's prophets left, but Baal has four hundred and fifty prophets.

Elijah and prophets of baal are to call fire down from heaven

God used the Prophet Elijah to rid Israel of the priests of baal; that Jezebel the wife of Ahab king of Israel had put in charge of her temple for the worship of baal. At this time Elijah thought he was the only Prophet God had left, he thought Jezebel had killed all the others.

Elijah purposes that He build a alter to his God and the priests of baal build an alter to their god for a burnt offering. They would each get a bullocks and they could choose theirs first and prepare it and be the first to sacrifice to their god. Then Elijah would give his evening sacrifice to the God of Israel. The priests of baal built their alter and put the wood and the sacrifice on the alter and began calling to their god to send fire down from heaven to burn up their sacrifice until noon, but their god wasn't able send fire down.

So Elijah repaired the alter of Israel's God and took twelve stones the number of the tribes of Israel to build the alter. He then dug a trench around it and put wood on the alter and the bullock for the sacrifice. He then had the people fill four barrels of water and pour it out on the sacrifice and the wood. Elijah had them do it three times, so water ran down off the alter filling the trench with water.

At the time of evening sacrifice Elijah came to the alter and said, "Lord God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel. Lord may the people know You are the God of Israel and I am your servant and have done according to your word." He then ask God too turn the hearts of the Israelites, back to Himself, once again. God then sent fire down from heaven and it consumed the sacrifice, the Alter and all the water in the trench. Elijah had the 450 prophets of baal killed, 1 Kings 23-40.

1Kings 18:23-40 Get two bulls for us. Let them choose one for themselves, and let them cut it into pieces and put it on the wood but not set fire to it. I will prepare the other bull and put it on the wood but not set fire to it. 24 Then you call on the name of your god, and I will call on the name of the Lord . The god who answers by fire-he is God." Then all the people said, "What you say is good." 25 Elijah said to the prophets of Baal, "Choose one of the bulls and prepare it first, since there are so many of you. Call on the name of your god, but do not light the fire." 26 So they took the bull given them and prepared it. Then they called on the name of Baal from morning till noon. "O Baal, answer us!" they shouted. But there was no response; no one answered. And they danced around the altar they had made. 27 At noon Elijah began to taunt them. "Shout louder!" he said. "Surely he is a god! Perhaps he is deep in thought, or busy, or traveling. Maybe he is

sleeping and must be awakened." 28 So they shouted louder and slashed themselves with swords and spears, as was their custom, until their blood flowed. 29 Midday passed, and they continued their frantic prophesying until the time for the evening sacrifice. But there was no response, no one answered, no one paid attention. 30 Then Elijah said to all the people, "Come here to me." They came to him, and he repaired the altar of the Lord , which was in ruins. 31 Elijah took twelve stones, one for each of the tribes descended from Jacob, to whom the word of the Lord had come, saying, "Your name shall be Israel." 32 With the stones he built an altar in the name of the Lord , and he dug a trench around it large enough to hold two seahs of seed. 33 He arranged the wood, cut the bull into pieces and laid it on the wood. Then he said to them, "Fill four large jars with water and pour it on the offering and on the wood." 34 "Do it again," he said, and they did it again. "Do it a third time," he ordered, and they did it the third time. 35 The water ran down around the altar and even filled the trench. 36 At the time of sacrifice, the prophet Elijah stepped forward and prayed: "O Lord , God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, let it be known today that you are God in Israel and that I am your servant and have done all these things at your command." 37 Answer me, O Lord , answer me, so these people will know that you, O Lord , are God, and that you are turning their hearts back again." 38 Then the fire of the Lord fell and burned up the sacrifice, the wood, the stones and the soil, and also licked up the water in the trench. 39 When all the people saw this, they fell prostrate and cried, "The Lord -he is God! The Lord -he is God!" 40 Then Elijah commanded them, "Seize the prophets of Baal. Don't let anyone get away!" They seized them, and Elijah had them brought down to the Kishon Valley and slaughtered there.

The Drought Ends 1 Kings 18:41-46

Elijah tells king Ahab, "Go and eat and drink for there is heavy rain coming." Ahab went to eat. Elijah went up on Mount Carmel with his servant to pray for rain. When Elijah saw cloud forming over the sea he went and told the king to go

to his palace so the rain wouldn't prevent him from going. When God's power came upon Elijah he ran ahead of the king's chariot back to the Jezreel.

1 Kings 18:41-46 And Elijah said to Ahab, "Go, eat and drink, for there is the sound of a heavy rain." 42 So Ahab went off to eat and drink, but Elijah climbed to the top of Carmel, bent down to the ground and put his face between his knees. 43 "Go and look toward the sea," he told his servant. And he went up and looked. "There is nothing there," he said. Seven times Elijah said, "Go back." 44 The seventh time the servant reported, "A cloud as small as a man's hand is rising from the sea." So Elijah said, "Go and tell Ahab, 'Hitch up your chariot and go down before the rain stops you.'" 45 Meanwhile, the sky grew black with clouds, the wind rose, a heavy rain came on and Ahab rode off to Jezreel. 46 The power of the Lord came upon Elijah and, tucking his cloak into his belt, he ran ahead of Ahab all the way to Jezreel.

Elijah Flees to Mount Horeb

King Ahab tells Jezebel all that Elijah had done and that he had killed all of her prophets. Jezebel threatened to kill Elijah so he fled to Beersheba where he left his servants, but he continued on for a day into the wilderness where he slept. An angel appeared to him two times feeding him so he could go and stay at Mount Horeb, the Mount of God in median 1 Kings 19:1-8.

1 Kings 19:1-8 Now Ahab told Jezebel everything Elijah had done and how he had killed all the prophets with the sword. 2 So Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah to say, "May the gods deal with me, be it ever so severely, if by this time tomorrow I do not make your life like that of one of them." 3 Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. When he came to Beersheba in Judah, he left his servant there, 4 while he himself went a day's journey into the desert. He came to a broom tree, sat down under it and prayed that he might die. "I have had enough, Lord," he said. "Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors." 5 Then he lay down under the tree and fell asleep. All at once an angel touched him and said, "Get up and eat." 6 He looked around, and there by his head was a cake of bread baked over

hot coals, and a jar of water. He ate and drank and then lay down again. 7 The angel of the Lord came back a second time and touched him and said, "Get up and eat, for the journey is too much for you." 8 So he got up and ate and drank. Strengthened by that food, he traveled forty days and forty nights until he reached Horeb, the mountain of God.

God appears to Elijah and he tells God the people of Israel had forsaken His covenant and torn down His Alters and have slain all of Gods Prophets and he, Elijah was the only one left and they were trying to kill him as well. God told Elijah that He has 7,000 Prophets that have not bowed a knee to baal. God told Elijah to go to the wilderness of Damascus and anoint Hazael as king over Syria and Jehu son of Nimshi over Israel. Then go to Elisha the son of Shapat of Abel-meholah and anoint him as a Prophet to replace you, 1 Kings 19:19-21.

Elijah Calls Elisha To Be A Prophet

1 Kings 19:21 There he went into a cave and spent the night. And the word of the Lord came to him: "What are you doing here, Elijah?" 10 He replied, "I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too." 11 The Lord said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord , for the Lord is about to pass by." Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord , but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. 12 After the earthquake came a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper. 13 When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave. Then a voice said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?" 14 He replied, "I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too." 15 The Lord said to him, "Go back the way you came, and go to the Desert of Damascus. When you get there, anoint

Hazael king over Aram. 16 Also, anoint Jehu son of Nimshi king over Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel Meholah to succeed you as prophet. 17 Jehu will put to death any who escape the sword of Hazael, and Elisha will put to death any who escape the sword of Jehu. 18 Yet I reserve seven thousand in Israel all whose knees have not bowed down to Baal and all whose mouths have not kissed him." 19 So Elijah went from there and found Elisha son of Shaphat. He was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair. Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him. 20 Elisha then left his oxen and ran after Elijah. "Let me kiss my father and mother good-bye," he said, "and then I will come with you." "Go back," Elijah replied. "What have I done to you?" 21 So Elisha left him and went back. He took his yoke of oxen and slaughtered them. He burned the plowing equipment to cook the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he set out to follow Elijah and became his attendant.

Elisha Spent Time As Elijah's Understudy

Elijah tried to have Elisha stay back when the Lord sent him from Gilgal to Bethel, but Elisha refused to stay and again Elijah tried to get Elisha to stay behind when he went to Jericho, but again Elisha refused to stay behind. Once again Elijah told Elisha to stay in Jericho while he went to the Jordan River but again Elisha would not because he knew God was going to take Elisha home to be with the Lord, Kings 2:1-8.

2 Kings 2:1-8 When the Lord was about to take Elijah up to heaven in a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way from Gilgal. 2 Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here; the Lord has sent me to Bethel." But Elisha said, "As surely as the Lord lives and as you live, I will not leave you." So they went down to Bethel. 3 The company of the prophets at Bethel came out to Elisha and asked, "Do you know that the Lord is going to take your master from you today?" "Yes, I know," Elisha replied, "but do not speak of it." 4 Then Elijah said to him, "Stay here, Elisha; the Lord has sent me to Jericho." And he replied, "As surely as the Lord lives and as you live, I will not leave you." So they went to Jericho. 5 The company of the

prophets at Jericho went up to Elisha and asked him, "Do you know that the Lord is going to take your master from you today?" "Yes, I know," he replied, "but do not speak of it." 6 Then Elijah said to him, "Stay here; the Lord has sent me to the Jordan." And he replied, "As surely as the Lord lives and as you live, I will not leave you." So the two of them walked on. 7 Fifty men of the company of the prophets went and stood at a distance, facing the place where Elijah and Elisha had stopped at the Jordan. 8 Elijah took his cloak, rolled it up and struck the water with it. The water divided to the right and to the left, and the two of them crossed over on dry ground.

Elijah Is Taken Up Into Heaven In A Chariot Of Fire Elisha Receives A Double Portion Of Elijah Anointing

Elijah ask Elisha if there was anything he could give him before he was taken up and Elisha asked for a double portion of Elijah's anointing. Elijah told him if he saw him taken up he would receive it if not he would not get a double portion of Elijah's anointing, 2 Kings 2: 9-12.

2 Kings 2:9-12 When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?" "Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit," Elisha replied. 10" You have asked a difficult thing," Elijah said, "yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be your's otherwise not." 11 As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind. 12 Elisha saw this and cried out, "My father! My father! The chariots and horsemen of Israel!" And Elisha saw him no more. Then he took hold of his own clothes and tore them apart.

Elisha received his double portion of Elisha's anointing and has now taken over as God's prophet, 2 Kings 2:13-14.

2 Kings 2:13-14 He picked up the cloak that had fallen from Elijah and went back and stood on the bank of the Jordan. 14 Then he took the cloak that had fallen from him and struck the water with it. "Where now is the Lord, the God of Elijah?"

he asked. When he struck the water, it divided to the right and to the left, and he crossed over.

Let's Look At Some Of The Miracles Elisha Performed

Elisha healed bad water so it would no longer cause death, 2 Kings 2:19-22.

2 Kings 2:19-22 The men of the city said to Elisha, "Look, our lord, this town is well situated, as you can see, but the water is bad and the land is unproductive." 20 "Bring me a new bowl," he said, "and put salt in it." So they brought it to him. 21 Then he went out to the spring and threw the salt into it, saying, "This is what the Lord says: 'I have healed this water. Never again will it cause death or make the land unproductive.' " 22 And the water has remained wholesome to this day, according to the word Elisha had spoken.

Elisha Helps A Widow Pay Off Her Debt.

Elisha helped a widow pay a debt after her husband died, who was from the company of Prophets, leaving a debt, so her sons would not be slaves because of the debt. By taking the small amount of oil she had increased, to fill many vessels to sell and cover her debt, 2 Kings 4:1-7.

2 Kings 4 1-7 The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the Lord . But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." 2 Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?" "Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a little oil." 3 Elisha said, "Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don't ask for just a few." 4 Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." 5 She left him and afterward shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. 6 When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing. 7 She went and told the man of God, and he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. You and your sons can live on what is left."

A Shunammite woman and her husband, built a room for Elisha and his servant to stayed in whenever he passed through. and also fed them. One day Elisha ask what he could do for them, she told them they had no son and her husband was old. Elisha told her in about a year she would have a son to hold. The woman became pregnant and about a year when Elisha came by she had a son as he had prophesied, 2 Kings 4:8-9; 14-17

2 Kings 4:8-9; 14-17 One day Elisha went to Shunem. And a well-to-do woman was there, who urged him to stay for a meal. So whenever he came by, he stopped there to eat. 9 She said to her husband, "I know that this man who often comes our way is a holy man of God. 10 Let's make a small room on the roof and put in it a bed and a table, a chair and a lamp for him. Then he can stay there whenever he comes to us."

14-17 "What can be done for her?" Elisha asked. Gehazi said, "Well, she has no son and her husband is old." 15 Then Elisha said, "Call her." So he called her, and she stood in the doorway. 16 "About this time next year," Elisha said, "you will hold a son in your arms." "No, my lord," she objected. "Don't mislead your servant, O man of God!" 17 But the woman became pregnant, and the next year about that same time she gave birth to a son, just as Elisha had told her.

The child grew and one day he died in his mother's arms. She took the child and laid him on Elisha's bed and went to find Elisha. She told Elisha her son had died and she was not going to leave without Elisha, he had his servant Benhazi take his staff and lay in on the child's head. When Elisha and the boy's mother arrive he found the child still lifeless. Elisha stretches out over the boy and waited and did it once more and the child sneezed seven times and opened his eyes, 2 Kings 4:20-26; 28-37.

2 Kings 4:20-26 After the servant had lifted him up and carried him to his mother, the boy sat on her lap until noon, and then he died. 21 She went up and laid him on the bed of the man of God, then shut the door and went out. 22 She called her husband and said, "Please send me one of the servants and a donkey so I can go to the man of God quickly and return." 23 "Why go to him today?" he

asked. "It's not the New Moon or the Sabbath." "It's all right," she said. 24 She saddled the donkey and said to her servant, "Lead on; don't slow down for me unless I tell you." 25 So she set out and came to the man of God at Mount Carmel. When he saw her in the distance, the man of God said to his servant Gehazi, "Look! There's the Shunammite! 26 Run to meet her and ask her, 'Are you all right? Is your husband all right? Is your child all right?'"

28-37 "Did I ask you for a son, my lord?" she said. "Didn't I tell you, 'Don't raise my hopes'?" 29 Elisha said to Gehazi, "Tuck your cloak into your belt, take my staff in your hand and run. If you meet anyone, do not greet him, and if anyone greets you, do not answer. Lay my staff on the boy's face." 30 But the child's mother said, "As surely as the Lord lives and as you live, I will not leave you." So he got up and followed her. 31 Gehazi went on ahead and laid the staff on the boy's face, but there was no sound or response. So Gehazi went back to meet Elisha and told him, "The boy has not awakened." 32 When Elisha reached the house, there was the boy lying dead on his couch. 33 He went in, shut the door on the two of them and prayed to the Lord . 34 Then he got on the bed and lay upon the boy, mouth to mouth, eyes to eyes, hands to hands. As he stretched himself out upon him, the boy's body grew warm. 35 Elisha turned away and walked back and forth in the room and then got on the bed and stretched out upon him once more. The boy sneezed seven times and opened his eyes. 36 Elisha summoned Gehazi and said, "Call the Shunammite." And he did. When she came, he said, "Take your son." 37 She came in, fell at his feet and bowed to the ground. Then she took her son and went out.

Elisha did many other miracles before he died. After his death they put his body in a cave, in the spring of the year Moabite raiders came into the country and two men were carrying a dead man to put him in the cave Elisha had been put. When the men saw the raiders they threw the man's body on the bones of Elisha and the man came back to life and stood up. Talk about a double anointing, even after Elisha had died his bones carried such anointing on them a dead man came back to life when his body fell on Elisha's bones, 2 Kings 13:20-21.

2 Kings 13:20-21 Elisha died and was buried. Now Moabite raiders used to enter the country every spring. 21 Once while some Israelites were burying a man, suddenly they saw a band of raiders; so they threw the man's body into Elisha's tomb. When the body touched Elisha's bones, the man came to life and stood up on his feet.

If the bones of Elisha had that much anointing on them, that a dead man who touches his bones comes back to life and the Lord is telling us that the anointing He is about to pour out is even greater than that of Elisha's. Ask yourself how can this be? The Lord has told us in a word of prophecy we are to ask Him to prepare us, so we can receive the fullness of His anointing, in other words we must have greater faith in the Lord and what He can do through us when we are completely filled with His Holy Spirit and power.

We must also have a personal intimate relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit so we can hear what father wants to do in and through us, as one of His spirit filled children. Jesus also said, Father will tell us what we are to speak and when we do so He can preform His great miracles through us, they will be so great the human mind won't be able to fathom them, John 14:10-12.

John 14:10-12. Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work. 11 **Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.** 12 I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father, John 10:30.

Jesus and the Father are one and we are one with Jesus when we make Him our Lord, because we have the Holy Spirit dwelling in us also. The Holy Spirit is God's power and Father will use the Holy Spirit in us to bring forth His great miracles. Father wants to use these great miracles to win the lost souls unto Jesus as we are in the last day, just before the tribulation begins. There is a great move of God taking place all around the world, a great move of repentance and revival, where

billions of souls are being brought into the kingdom of heaven.
