

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT AND WHY IS HE IMPORTANT?

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Holy Spirit's Involvement In Creation

Through this teaching I hope to show how satan and his demons use people to attacked our ancestors and us today and help you become free of his attacks.

God created man to love and care for and to have a personal intimate relationship with, Genesis chapter 1-3; Genesis 3:8-10; Romans 5:5.

Out of God's great love for man, He provided for his every need, a place to live, food to eat and clothed them in His righteousness.

I hope you will be able to see how each of the subjects may have affected you in one way or another, as you were growing up and how they may still be affecting your life today.

I believe this presentation could help you deal with the different problems, whether they are a problem you have been facing or someone you know.

God created the heavens and earth for man and He and Jesus gave forth their Light for 3 days. Gen. 1:1-5, it was the 1st day.

God said, "Separate the water under the sky from the water above the sky," Gen. 1:6-8. the 2nd day. Making the earth a green house.

Carl Baugh of Creation Evidence Museum, at 3102 FM 205 Glen Rose, Texas 76043, believes the earth was inside a bubble of ice.

God said, "Collect the water under the sky into seas," and create dry ground, vegetation, grass, bushes and trees to produce food. Gen. 1:9-13, the 3rd day.

God said, "Let there be light" activating the sun moon and stars to give light to mark seasons days and years, Gen. 1:14-19, the 4th day.

God said, "Produce sea life and the birds of the air. Genesis 1:20-23, the 5th day.

God said, "Let the land produce living creatures, wild animals, livestock and other life forms that move on the ground, according to its kind," Genesis 1:25.

God said, "Lets make man in our image, in our likeness," creating them male and female Genesis 1:24-31; (gods), the 6th day. In Psalms 82:6-7, I (God) said,

“you are gods, you are all sons of the Most- High.” and in John 10:34, Jesus speaking, said, “Is it not written in your law, I said you are gods.”

God gave Adam three commands, # 1. Be fruitful and replenish the earth and subdue the earth (conquer). Command #2. Take dominion (absolute control) over all air breathing life on earth Genesis 1:28.

Genesis 1:29 God told Adam he could eat of every tree that had seeds in them.

Genesis 2:15-17 Command # 3. You can eat of every tree in the garden, but not the fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. The day you eat of it you will surely die! They died both spiritually and physically in a day of the Lord, 2 Peter 3:8

Genesis 3:1-7 When the serpent tempted Eve, Adam was with her.

The reason satan attacked Eve and not Adam is because she had a womb.

Ephesians 6:10-18. Our battle is not against flesh and blood but against the powers of this dark world. 1 Cor. 14:1-5, Seek Spiritual gifts at least tongues.

Genesis 1:28. Adam only kept part 1 of the 1st commandment, to be fruitful, and broke the 2nd half, by not subduing the earth. Genesis 2:16-17 Adam broke the 2nd and 3rd commandment, by not take dominion over the serpent and by eating the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 3:6-8. When Adam and Eve ate the fruit they knew they were naked.

Genesis 3:9-10. When Jesus came down in the cool of the evening to walk with Adam and Eve; they knew they were naked and hid from the Lord

Genesis 3:11-13. When asked who told you; you were naked, have you eaten of the forbidden fruit. Adam accused the Lord, of give him the woman Eve and she gave him the fruit to eat and Eve blamed the serpent, by saying, “he tricked me.” Adam and Eve didn’t ask for the forgiveness of their sins. Their un-forgiven sins, gives satan an open door, to attack us and our families Exodus 20:4-5 This was the beginning of the un-forgiven sins of our ancestors and it still goes on to this very day. Our ancestor’s un-forgiven sins can open us up to satins attack on our lives and our children’s lives.

1 John 1:9 *If we ask for the forgiveness of our sins, in Jesus name they are forgiven.* **Psalms 103:12** *They are cast as far as the East is from the west.*

When we ask for the forgiveness of our sins they are forgiven, but there are still side effects and a residue left and satan will use them to attack us.

Prayer to be Set Completely Free

We need to ask Jesus to take your hurts or sins upon Himself, the side effects and residue and say, "Thank You Jesus. Next ask Him to forgive you of letting them affect your life. Then say Jesus I forgive myself thank You Jesus.

Genesis 3:14-15, *God cursed the serpent and told him he would crawl on his belly and eat dust all the days of its life and the seed of woman, (Jesus) would crush his head and he (satan) would strike the heel of Jesus.* God prophesied about Christ Jesus our Redeemer in the 3rd chapter of Genesis, Rom. 16:20.

Genesis 3:16-19 *God said, He would cause woman to have increased pain in childbirth.* *God put a curse on the earth to produce thorns and thistles, so man would eat of the plants of the field, by the sweat of his brow.* *Adam did not repent nor did Eve, so the Lord killed an animal (most likely a lamb) to cover over their sins with the blood of a lamb and the skin to cover their nakedness.*

Genesis 3:22 *Jesus preformed the first animal sacrifice.* He then drove them from the garden.

2 Peter 3:8. *Adam and Eve died spiritually the instant they ate the forbidden fruit and physically before a day of the Lord could pass. A day of the Lord is 1,000 years and 1,000 years as a day, so they died the day they ate the fruit.*

Genesis Chapters 1 through 50 *God reached out to man during Old Testament times through,* Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, David, Solomon and finally His Son Jesus, who brings back life to our spirit man.

John 1:1-4; 10-12 *Finally God reached out to man by sending His Son Jesus to wash away our sins.* **John 3:3-5**, *(believe in Christ and become sons of God).*

John 1:1-4; 10-12 Finally God reached out to man by sending His Son Jesus to wash away our sins. John 3:3-5, (believe in Christ and become sons of God).

John 4:23-24 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshiper will worship the Father in Spirit and truth also 1 Corinthians 14:1-5.

John 14:6 To have a personal relationship with God one must make Jesus their Lord.

1 John 1:9 Confess your sins to God the Father and ask Jesus to come into your heart and be your Savior and Lord. Romans 10:9-10 If it is a heartfelt desire; you will receive the Holy Spirit and become a child of God. You can now have a personal intimate relationship with Jesus and God through your renewed spirit Romans 8:14-16; (from death by Adam's sins to Life through Christ Jesus).

Exodus 20:4-5 The sins of our father's will go down to the children of the 3rd and 4th generation of those who Hate God and I believe they will keep on going until God; can send someone to work through, to brake them off, is it you?

Romans 5:12. We must tell the Lord we forgive our ancestors, of all their unforgiven sins, all the way back to Adam. Then ask Jesus to take the sins upon Himself and all of their side effect and residue. Next ask Jesus to forgive you for letting them affect your life. Then say, "I forgive myself," "Thank you Jesus."

Jeremiah 1:4-5 (Prophet) 2 Corinthians 5:20 (Ambassador); Ephesians 1:3-7, I believe every one of us were sent into the world with a calling on our lives.

We Need to Know Who We are in Christ Jesus

Anyone who has faith in Christ Jesus will do what Jesus did while on earth and even greater things, because He has gone to the Father (God), John 14:12.

As God's child we must operate in the gifts of Holy Spirit, His power and be taught how to use them, 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 (gifts of the Spirit); Ephesians 6:10-18, Matthew 18:18-19 (power to bind and loose in the name Jesus); John 14:26, (Holy Spirit our comforter, teacher and Power by faith in Christ Jesus).

HOLY SPIRIT ONE THIRD OF THE GOD HEAD

The Holy Spirit is one third of the God Head, God the Father; God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

What I am about to say may offend some of you, so I want to say I am sorry if you were offended; but, I was where some of you are most of my life. I had never given much thought about the Holy Spirit or His importance in my life. I believed in the Holy Trinity, God the Father; God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, but that was the extent of my knowledge of, or the workings of the Holy spirit, but the Lord has put on my heart recently; to teach about the workings of the Holy Spirit and be used by the Holy Spirit to write this article. I have since come to understand, just how important God's Holy Spirit is, to each and every one of us.

As we start back at the beginning of time, when God Jesus and Holy took something dead; that was formless and void of light or life and created our world, a living world, Genesis chapters one and two.

Genesis 1:1-5. 1 the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 Now the earth was formless and void, darkness was over the surface of the deep and the Spirit of God was hovering over the water. 3 And God said, "Let there be light" and there was light. 4 God saw the light was good and He separated the light from the darkness. 5 God called the light day and the darkness He called night. And there was evening and morning—the **first day.**

As you can see Holy Spirit was with God during the creation of the world as we know it today. It is no longer formless and void. As you read the rest of chapter 1 and 2 you will see how much more God created through Jesus, by the power of His Spirit (Holy Spirit). On the 6th day He created Man and woman. We will now go to John 1:1-4 and see what the Apostle John had to say about the creation of the world.

John 1:1-4 In the beginning was the **Word (Jesus)** and **the Word was with God** and **the Word was God.** 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through Him

all things were made (*by the power of the Holy Spirit*) without Him (Jesus) nothing was made that was made. 4 **In Him, was life and light** and that light was the light of man, also **Revelation 22:5**, (*There is no night **because** God and Jesus is the light*).

Here again we see the Holy Spirit working through Jesus in the beginning just as we read in Genesis chapter one. One may ask what makes you think the Holy Spirit moved and created light. I believe we can find the answer in the Book of Romans chapter 8:7-11.

Romans 8:7-11 The sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. 8 Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God. 9 **You however, are not controlled by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you.** And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. 10 But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness. 11 **And if the Spirit of Him (Holy Spirit) who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.**

As you can see God used His Holy Spirit to raise Christ Jesus from the dead and will raise all who have the Holy Spirit living in them, what a great and glorious promise we have in Christ Jesus, if that is not enough let us continue.

Ephesians 1:13-14 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. **Having believed, you were marked in Him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,** 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of His glory.

Luke 1:26-31 In the sixth month, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, 27 **to a virgin pledged to be married** to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. **The virgin's name was Mary.** 28 The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." 29 Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be.

30 But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. **31 You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus.**

Luke 1:34-35 "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?" 35 The angel answered, "**The Holy Spirit will come upon you,** and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. **So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.** (*The Holy Spirit was involved in Jesus being conceived*).

As you can see Jesus came into the world through His mother's womb just as you and I did, but Jesus was not born into sin, as there was no sins of the Father involved, because His Father was God. Even Jesus needed to be filled with the Holy Spirit to be able to carry out the calling that was placed on His life and live a life without falling in to sin, when He was sent here by God the Father.

Matthew 3:13-17 **Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John.** 14 But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" 15 **Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness."** Then John consented. 16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. **At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him.** 17 And a voice from heaven said, "**This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.**"

Matthew 4:1-11 **Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil.** 2 After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. 3 The tempter came to him and said, "**If you are the Son of God,** tell these stones to become bread." 4 **Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'**" 5 Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. 6 "**If you are the Son of God,**" he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: " 'He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.' " 7 **Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'**" 8 Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and

their splendor. 9 "All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me." 10 Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.' 11 Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.

If Jesus needed the filling of the Holy Spirit, why would any person think; God would send us here with a calling on our lives and not provide us with the means to carry out our calling? He didn't; He has made it possible for His children to receive the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit just as He did for Jesus His only begotten Son, our Lord and Savior. I believe Jesus was fully man up until the time, He prayed to His Father; for the glory He had while with Him in heaven.

*In the Book of John chapter 17:4-5, Jesus is praying to His Heavenly Father, saying He had finished what He was sent to do and **now Jesus needed the glory and presence He had with the Father before the world began,** John 17:4-5; 8-9; 20-24.*

***It tells us Jesus left the glory He had with the Father in heaven, when He came into the world through the womb of Mary.** Jesus would now need the glory He had with God the Father, while in Heaven, **to withstand the Cross and the sins of the world;** that would be placed upon Him. Take this scripture and the one in John 17:8-9 Jesus then goes on to explain some of the other things He had completed.*

John 17:4-5 I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do. 5 And **now, Father, glorify Me in Your presence with the glory I had with You before the world began.** (Jesus is about to be arrested, tried and crucified).

John 17:8-9 For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. 9 I pray for them. **I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours.**

John 17:20-24 "**My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us** so that the world may believe that you have sent Me. 22 I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: 23 **I in them and you in me.** May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved Me. 24 "**Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.**

Jesus was made in the likeness of sinful man and sent unto earth through His mother's womb with the assignment, to put into place the means for man to receive his redemption from sin, so we could once again have an intimate relationship with God the Father, Jesus and Holy Spirit, Romans 8:1-4; 7-14.

Romans 8:1-4 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in sinful man, 4 in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:7-11 the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. 8 Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God. 9 You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. **And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.** 10 **But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness.** 11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.

Ephesians 2:4-6 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy,

5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by grace you have been saved. 6 **And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, Ephesians 2:4-6.**

Galatians 4:1-7 is in agreement with Romans chapter 8 where it is stated that the Holy Spirit will testify with our spirit that we are a child of God.

Galatians 4:1-7 What I am saying is that as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. 2 He is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his father. 3 So also, when we were children, we were in slavery under the basic principles of the world. 4 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, 5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. 6 **Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."** 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

Romans 8:12-17 Therefore, brothers, we have an obligation--but it is not to the sinful nature, to live according to it. 13 For if you live according to the sinful nature, you will die but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live, 14 because **those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.** 15 For you did not receive the spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." 16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. 17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs--heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

Hebrews 7:11-19 If perfection could have been attained through the Levitical priesthood (for on the basis of it the law was given to the people), why was there still need for another priest to come--one in the order of Melchizedek, not in the order of Aaron? 12 For when there is a change of the priesthood, there must also be a change of the law. 13 He of whom these things are said belonged to a different tribe, and no one from that tribe has ever served at the altar. 14 For it is

clear that our Lord descended from Judah, and in regard to that tribe Moses said nothing about priests. 15 **And what we have said is even more-clear if another priest like Melchizedek appears,** 16 one who has become a priest not on the basis of a regulation as to his ancestry but on the basis of the power of an indestructible life. 17 **For it is declared: "You are a priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek."** 18 The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless 19 **(for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God.**

Just as with Jesus every one of us were sent here through our mother's womb with a calling on our life. If we go to the book of Ephesians we can get a better under-standing of who we become through Christ Jesus, Ephesians 1:1-14.

Ephesians 1:1-14 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God. To the saints in Ephesus, the faithful in Christ Jesus: 2 Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. 3 **Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.** 4 **For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.** In love 5 He predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will-- 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. 7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace 8 that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. 9 **And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ,** 10 to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment--to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ. 11 In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, 12 in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. 13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit, guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who

are God's possession--to the praise of his glory.

*We just read in verses 13 and 14 that **God's Holy Spirit is the sign and seal of our salvation, so if a person doesn't have the indwelling of the Holy Spirit they are not a child of God,** 1 Corinthians 2:9; Colossians 1:26-27 & 1 Peter 1:12.*

*Let's look and see what the Lord Jesus has to say about what one must do to enter into the kingdom of heaven, **John 14:6***

John 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 14:12 I tell you the truth, anyone who has (*great*) faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

John 14:15-20 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. 16 **You did not choose me, but I chose you** and appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. 17 **This is my command: Love each other.** 18 "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. 19 If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you. 20 Remember the words I spoke to you: 'No servant is greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also. If they obeyed my teaching, they will obey yours also.

This brings us to a point, where we will need to know, what one must do to receive the Holy Spirit. Let's go to the book of John where Jesus is speaking to a Pharisee by the name of Nicodemus, who came to Him by night to ask Jesus how one could be born again, John 3:1-7.

John 3:1-7 Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a member of the Jewish ruling council. 2 He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him." 3 In reply Jesus

declared, "**I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.**" 4 "How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!" 5 Jesus answered, "**I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.**" 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again, **1 Corinthians 15:50** Flesh and blood can't enter the kingdom of heaven.

*We just received a confirmation from Jesus that one must have the Holy Spirit in order to enter into the kingdom of heaven. **Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, (so we will need to be born again).** Romans 5:12; 16:18.*

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned.

Romans 5:15-18 But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did **God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many!** 16 Again, the gift of God is not like the result of the one man's sin: The judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation, but the gift followed many trespasses and brought justification. 17 For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. 18 Consequently, just as the result of one trespass was condemnation for all men, **so also the result of one act of righteousness was justification that brings life for all men.**

God's righteousness comes through the righteousness blood of Christ Jesus.

Romans 23:22-25 This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 **and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.** 25 **God presented him as a sacrifice of**

atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished.

We have been told by Jesus that we need to have the Holy Spirit to enter into the kingdom of heaven, He said, we needed to be born of water and the Spirit or we will not enter into the kingdom of heaven. And we know why, because we were all born into the original sin of Adam, If we go to Romans 10:8-10 to see what the Apostle Paul has to say about how to receive the Holy Spirit..

Romans 10:8-10 But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: 9 **That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.** 10 **For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved, (if we ask Jesus to be Lord of our Life)!**

Now if you have made Jesus Lord of your life is there more? Yes there is much more, when we make Jesus Lord of our life we are born again and have receive the Holy Spirit, His Gifts, the power God had given Adam in the beginning and more. Genesis 1:26-28.

Genesis 1:27-28 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground 28 God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. **Rule over (take dominion over King James Bible) the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."**

This was Old Testament scripture, now let's see what the Apostle Paul has to say is available to the born again believer through Christ, 1 Corinthians 12:4-11.

1 Corinthians 12:4-11 There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. 6 There are different kinds

of working, but the same God works all of them in all men. 7 **Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.** 8 To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, 10 to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. 11 All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.

The Holy Spirit gives to each one of God's children the gifts, they will need to carry out the calling God put on their life, when He sent them to earth through their mother's womb. But one must believe the gifts are available to them and earnestly seek them in order to have them activated by the Holy Spirit.

I Corinthians 14:1-5.

I Corinthians 14:1-5 Follow the way of love and eagerly desire spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy. 2 **For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit.** 3 But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort. 4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church. 5 I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy. He who prophesies is greater than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may be edified.

Now there are people even pastors who will tell you the gifts of the Spirit are no longer available to a child of God today, but they believe if you seek the gifts of the Holy Spirit you could get a spirit from the devil. It is impossible to get an evil spirit from satan; if you are born again, because the Spirit of God who lives in you is greater than any demon or evil spirit satan has, END OF STORY.

Let's go to Matthew 7:7-11, there we will find what the Apostle Matthew has to say about asking God for his gifts.

Matthew 7:7-11 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened. 9 "Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? 10 If he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? 11 If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

Others will tell you the Gifts of the Holy Spirit died out when the last Apostle died based on 1 Corinthians 13:8-10.

1 Corinthians 13:8-10 Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. 9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, 10 but when perfection comes, the imperfect disappears. (***The perfection is Christ Jesus.***)

That is not true because prophecies are still being fulfilled today, people are still speaking in different languages and knowledge is doubling in a year or less. I rest my case on these facts and the facts revealed in the scriptures below, because many born again believer's in Christ Jesus operated in the Spirit's gifts. They still do to this very day and I am also one who dose. Once such person was Philip we read about him in the Book of Acts, Acts 6:3-5; 8:4-8; 34-40.

Acts 6:1-5 In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Grecian Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. 2 So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. 3 **Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom.** We will turn this responsibility over to them 4 and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word." 5 This proposal pleased the whole group. **They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit; also Philip,** Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas from Antioch, a convert to Judaism.

We will pick up the story of Philip in Acts 8:4-8.

Acts 8:4-8 Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went. 5 **Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Christ there.** 6 **When the crowds heard Philip and saw the miraculous signs he did, they all paid close attention to what he said.** 7 **With shrieks, evil spirits came out of many, and many paralytics and cripples were healed.** 8 **So there was great joy in that city.**

Acts 8:34-40 The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" 35 Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. 36 As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?" 37 Philip said, **"If you believe with all your heart, you may."** **And he replied, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."** 38 And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him. 39 **When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away,** and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing. 40 **Philip, however, appeared at Azotus** and traveled about, preaching the gospel in all the towns until he reached Caesarea.

Another person we could look at is Cornelius a Roman Centurion of the Italian Regiment *was told by an angel to send for Simon Peter, who was in Joppa, so he sent for Peter and Peter came with some other Jews. Cornelius called all his family and friends, so when Peter arrived and preached about Jesus, Cornelius and His whole house hold received their salvation and began speaking in tongues and praising God.* Acts 10:42-47.

Acts 10:42-47 He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead. 43 All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name." 44 **While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message.** 45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit

had been poured out even on the Gentiles. **46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.** 47 Then Peter said, "Can anyone keep these people from being baptized with water? They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have."

One more incident that stands out is in Acts 19 where Paul met 12 young believers who had not been baptized in the name of Jesus. They had only received the baptism of repentance from John the Baptist.

Acts 19:1-7 While Apollos was at Corinth, **Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples 2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"** They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." 3 So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?" "John's baptism," they replied. 4 Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus." 5 **On hearing this, they were baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus.** 6 When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied. 7 There were about twelve men in all.

In the Book of 1 Corinthians 2:1-9 where the Apostle Paul told the Christians in Corinth, when he came to them he didn't come with eloquence of speech or super wisdom, but came in weakness, fear and trembling, with a message of Christ crucified and in the power of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:1-9 When I came to you, brothers, I did not come with eloquence or superior wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. 2 **For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.** 3 I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling. 4 My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, 5 **so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.** 6 We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. 7 No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom

that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. 8 None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 However, as it is written: "**No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him.**" God's secret wisdom; the Spirit of Christ in us, our hope of glory!

Now we will turn to the Book of acts 19:11-12 to see what Paul was referring to when he spoke about a demonstration of the Spirits power.

Acts 19:11-12 God did extraordinary miracles through Paul, 12 so that even handkerchiefs and aprons that had touched him were taken to the sick, and their illnesses were cured and the evil spirits left them.

There is an incident where 7 sons of a Jewish Priest, were going around casting out evil spirits in the name of Jesus, who Paul preached. One day an evil spirit turned on them and beat them bloody, so they ran out of the house into the street naked. They didn't have the authority to use the Name of Jesus and they didn't have the Holy Spirit dwelling in them, Acts 19:13-16.

Acts 19:13-16 Some Jews who went around driving out evil spirits tried to invoke the name of the Lord Jesus over those who were demon-possessed. They would say, "In the name of Jesus, whom Paul preaches, I command you to come out." 14 Seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this. 15 **One day the evil spirit answered them, "Jesus I know, and I know about Paul, but who are you?"** 16 **Then the man who had the evil spirit jumped on them and overpowered them all.** He gave them such a beating that they ran out of the house naked and bleeding.

Now that we have seen how the Holy Spirit moves through a believer who has faith in Jesus and the power of His Spirit and the opposite, when a person doesn't have faith in and a personal relationship with Jesus. Let's go to the book of Mark 16:14-18 and see what Jesus had to say on the subject.

Mark 16:14-18 Later Jesus appeared to the Eleven as they were eating; he rebuked them for their lack of faith and their stubborn refusal to believe those

who had seen him after he had risen. 15 He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. 16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. 17 **And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.**"

There is another incident pertaining to Paul's ministry I would like you to see. It takes place when Paul was arrested and being taken to Rome for trial. The ship he was on encountered a storm and was shipwrecked on the island of Malta off the coast of Italy, Acts chapters 27 and 28.

Acts 27:22-26 But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed. 23 **Last night an angel of the God whose I am and whom I serve stood beside me** 24 and said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul. You must stand trial before Caesar; and God has graciously given you the lives of all who sail with you.' 25 So keep up your courage, men, for I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me. **26 Nevertheless, we must run aground on some island.**"

Acts 27:30-34 In an attempt to escape from the ship, the sailors let the lifeboat down into the sea, pretending they were going to lower some anchors from the bow. 31 Then Paul said to the centurion and the soldiers, "Unless these men stay with the ship, you cannot be saved." 32 So the soldiers cut the ropes that held the lifeboat and let it fall away. 33 Just before dawn Paul urged them all to eat. "For the last fourteen days," he said, "you have been in constant suspense and have gone without food-- you haven't eaten anything. 34 Now I urge you to take some food. You need it to survive. Not one of you will lose a single hair from his head."

Acts 28:1-6 **Once safely on shore**, we found out that the island was called Malta. 2 The islanders showed us unusual kindness. They built a fire and welcomed us all because it was raining and cold. 3 **Paul gathered a pile of brushwood and, as he put it on the fire, a viper, driven out by the heat, fastened itself on his hand.** 4

When the islanders saw the snake hanging from his hand, they said to each other, "This man must be a murderer; for though he escaped from the sea, Justice has not allowed him to live." 5 But Paul shook the snake off into the fire and suffered no ill effects. 6 The people expected him to swell up or suddenly fall dead, but after waiting a long time and seeing nothing unusual happen to him, they changed their minds and said he was a god.

I want you to remember what Jesus told us in John 14:12-13.

John 14:12-13 I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. 13 And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

Now with all the information you have received about who the Holy Spirit is and what He will do for the born again believer in Christ Jesus. I would like to tell you how the Holy Spirit became a part of my life after I was born again.

As I told you earlier many pastors will tell you the gifts of the Spirit are no longer available to the children of God today, I am here to tell you, that is a lie directly from the pit of hell. They are definitely available to the born again believer, but he or she must truly believe they are available and earnestly seek the gifts. It will become much easier to receive the gifts as a person gets more scripture in their spirit. The more scripture a person has learned and believes the more the Holy Spirit has to work with to help you receive His gifts.

*I had grown up going to church most of my life and had never been taught about the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Over the years I became a Deacon in the church I had grown up in and eventually become an Elder of the church. All this time I was not born again, I only thought I was. **At 11:00 PM April 28, 1988 while getting ready for bed the Lord told me I was not His child, talk about a wakeup call.** I immediately got down on my knees by the side of my bed and confessed my sins as I had done many times before, but this time from the bottom of a broken and contrite heart, I asked Jesus to be Lord of my life. Instantly I had the peace I had*

never felt before, contentment and tears running down my cheeks; I was 53 years old at the time. **Why the tears? Go to Romans 5:5 for the answer!**

My Great Grand Father was a Freemason and when Grand Father died the spirits of masonry that was on him transferred to me, the oldest son in our family, I was 6 1/2 years old, at the time Grand Father died and all this was unknown to me at the time. I didn't learn about it until Memorial Day 2015, I was 80 years old, before I learned Great Grand Father was a Freemason.

Mother had taken us kids to Bible School one summer when I was about 5 years Old, at that time I went up front and ask Jesus to be my Savior and Lord and from that time until the Lord told me I was not His child, I thought I was born again and if I died I would go to heaven. I had not learned that a person had to make a commitment to Jesus once we reached the age of understanding. So I was not born again until I was 53 years old, during those 46 ½ years satan tried to kill me at least 6 times that I know of. I believe Jesus was honoring my child like faith and commitment to Him; thank you Jesus!

In 1988 when I was born again I developed a hunger for God's Word and to grow in His knowledge, from that time on the Holy Spirit started to guide my life and teaching me, then in August of 1991 I received my heavenly language spoken of in 1 Corinthians 14:1-5. After receiving the gift of a tongue I spent many hours conversing with the Lord in the spirit. The church I grew up in didn't believe in the gifts of the Holy Spirit, so it became increasingly harder to function as an Elder.

In the year 2004 I started volunteering at the Healing Rooms in Grand Rapids Michigan, where I started standing in for the dads of many, hurting individuals, who came and I express the love he was unable to express. It was a very humbling experience because my own dad was unable to tell me he loved me or was proud of what I was doing. While at the Healing Rooms I was involved in deliverance and saw people set free of spiritual bondage. By this time I no longer felt I could continue to grow in my faith if I stayed in the church I grew up in so I left.

With the experience I receive at the Healing Rooms I became closer to the Lord and began receiving Words of Knowledge from Him, then in 2009 the Lord gave

me the gift of interpretation of tongues. *The Holy Spirit and Jesus has taught me to ask questions by thought, so satan and his demons and evil spirits would not know what we are discussing and I also will receive His answers by thought as well. However satan can put thoughts in our mind, so one has to determine if the thought is from the Lord, or it could also be coming from the realm of our soul or satan's spirits. I will never ask the Lord for conformation on a subject a brother or sister and I are discussing, I learned to wait a while before I ask and will ask several times at random intervals, so I don't get the wrong answer from satan or his hoards.*

I have learned from the Holy Spirit over time that God, Jesus and Holy Spirit long to have a close intimate relationship with each and every one of us and that is the reason God sent Jesus to die and shed His blood so we can be set free of our sins. Once we truly make Jesus Lord of our life we receive the indwelling of the Holy Spirit and in so doing we are able to seek a close intimate relationship with the Lord, as we learn to yield more completely to Jesus.

One other scripture I want to leave with you is Matthew 18:18-20.

Matthew 18:18-20 "I tell you the truth, **whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.** 19 "Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. 20 For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." *I also want to remind you once again about John 14:12.*

John 14:12 I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. **He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.**

There is so much more to tell you but I don't know where to go from here at this point in time, but I believe the Holy Spirit is saying I should stop and let Him take the information I have given you to lead you in carrying out the calling God has placed on your life.

I am including some words of knowledge concerning what the Lord is saying He wants us to be doing, at this point in time and also some prayers I received from the Lord; God bless you as you walk out your Calling.
